To be eligible you must:

- Be 19-30 years old.
- Have not previously participated in the program.
- Submit an essay on why RPCA should consider you to be part of the program.
- Submit a completed application no later than November 20th.
- Be able to attend the next scheduled conference in January.

Applications must be submitted no later than November 20th. All applications will be reviewed by the Fund committee. If you are selected, you will be notified by December 10th.
